WHEREAS the Official Court Reporter of the 76th Judicial District of Texas, J. B. Redrearn, of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, is at present drawing a salary of \$4680.00 per year, (or \$590.00 per month) apportioned among the five counties of the District, and

WHEREAS due to the high prices of food commodities and other increases in the cost of living, the present salary is not in keeping with the advances of living cost. And the Court deems that the salary should be increased \$50.00 per month, or an increase of \$600.00 per year, making a salary of \$5280.00 per year, or \$440.00 per month, commencing September 1, 1955, and to be apportioned prorate among the 5 counties on a per month basis as follows:

Camp County - - - \$72.21

Franklin County - \$56.04

Marien County - -\$110.37

Morris County - - \$72.21

Titus County - - \$129.17
