and the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF RECOMMENDATION OF COUNTY JUDGE HARRY TAYLOR:

A recommendation was made by County Judge Harry Taylor that because of the cost of operating of the Peace Officers Dept. that the following be done in order to cut operating expenses:


1. That the Constable's force be reduced to one man;
2. That the Court would no longer pay \$30.00 per month on the Sheriff's Cook;
3. That the cost per day for feeding prisoner's in the jail be reduced from 90¢ to 80¢ per day.

No action was taken on this recommendation. It was decided to discuss it at a later date.
