 IN THE MATTER OF MINUTE ORDER NUMBER 35201- FARM TO MARKET ROAD:

TITUS COUNTY  
 DISTRICT NO. 19

In TITUS COUNTY the following described roads are hereby designated as FARM-TO-MARKET ROADS subject to the availability of funds in the Farm-to-Market Road fund as established by Senate Bill 287, 51st Legislature, and subject to the further condition that Titus County will furnish all required right-of-way free of cost to the State;

From U. S. Highway 271 North of Mt. Pleasant Northwest to road intersection, a distance of approximately 6.3 miles.

From end of F.M. Road 1001 at Argo Northeast to end of F.M. Road 1985, a distance of approximately 2.8 miles.

Upon acceptance by the County and fulfillment of the condition of this Order the State Highway Engineer is directed to proceed with construction in the most feasible and economical manner, at an estimated cost of \$121,000 and to assume the roads for maintenance upon completion of construction.
