IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING MONTHLY ACCOUNTS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Ponder and Seconded by Commissioner Mankins to approve the monthly accounts as same appear of record in Warrant Book No. 1. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING COUNTY TREASURER'S MONTHLY AND QUARTERLY REPORTS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Ponder and seconded by Commissioner Roper to approve the County Treasurer's monthly and quarterly reports for the month of September and the third quarter. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING THE MONTHLY EXPENSE ACCOUNTS OF OFFICERS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Mankins and seconded by Commissioner Banks to approve the officers monthly expense accounts as follows:

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING BONDS FOR DEPUTY SHERIFF AND DEPUTY TAX ASSESSOR-COLLECTOR:

Motion was made by Commissioner Ponder and seconded by Commissioner Banks to approve M. H. Gaddis' bond for deputy sheriff and Wallace R. Fields' bond for deputy tax assessor-collector. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF SETTING SALARY OF WALLACE R. FIELDS:

MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER ROPER AND SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER MANKINS to approve \$250.00 per month salary for Wallace R. Fields as deputy tax assessor-collector. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF TRANSFERRING FUNDS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Mankins and seconded by Commissioner Ponder to transfer \$300.00 from Operating Fund to General Co. Interest and Sinking Fund. Motion carried.
