 IN THE MATTER OF CLOSING ROAD:

THE STATE OF TEXAS |

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF SAID COUNTY:

The undersigned citizens and freeholders in Precinct No. 3, Titus County, Texas, represents to said court that the hereinafter described portion of a certain County lateral road has served its purpose and is no longer needed as a public road; that it has ceased to be used by the public due to the fact that other roads have been built and improved to the extent that said road is no longer being used and the public is properly and amply served with other roads and that the portion of road hereinafter described has not been maintained by the county or state for many years; that it would be to the best interest of the public and community to close said road. The road sought to be closed is a part of the old Harts Bluff Road and described as follows:

BEGINNING at the SE corner of a 36.9 acre tract of land owned by J. I. Crump out of E. O. Dutton Survey, Abat. No. 573, same also being about 2 miles North of Wilkinson School and at the intersection of Old Harts Bluff Road and a County Road leading to the West;

THENCE EAST approximately 40 feet to the EB line of Old Harts Bluff Road;  
 THENCE NORTH to the NW corner of an 80 acre tract of land owned by Alvin Blalock  
 out of the S. A. Bease Survey, Abstract No. 88;  
 THENCE WEST approximately 40 \_ to WB line of Old Harts Bluff Road and Crump land;  
 THENCE SOUTH with the WB line of said road to the place of beginning.

It is the intention of the undersigned to close only that portion of a certain  
 county road commonly known as Old Harts Bluff Road which is above described and which is  
 located in Precinct No. 3, Titus County, Texas, and would show to the court that the closing  
 of said road would be to the best interest of the public and that said portion of said road  
 should be in all things closed, the undersigned being resident citizens of the community in  
 which said road is located.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, the undersigned citizens and residents of the  
 community in which said road is located prays the court for an order closing said road to  
 public use.
