TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF SAID COUNTY:

It has been brought to the courts attention that the Texas Highway Department in reconstructing parts of State Highway 11 thru Titus County, from the Morris County line to the Camp County line, that the reconstruction has resulted in the abandonment of portions of old Highway 11. Adjoining property owners have approached the court on the relinquishment of this abandoned road to them.

On this day Jan. 10, 1955 Commissioner Ponder has made a motion only seconded by Commissioner Banks that the Court request the Texas Highway Department thru a copy of this order to relinquish to the abutting property owners all of this abandoned road of old State Highway 11 that is not needed further for highway purposes. The commissioners Court of Titus County further certifies to the Texas Highway Department that these abandoned sections of old Highway 11 are of no value for road purposes to the county.
