 IN THE MATTER OF TRANSFERING FUNDS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Ponder and seconded by Commissioner Roper to transfer \$100.00 from General County Fund to Peace Officer's Fund. Motion carried.

 IN THE MATTER OF STRAIGHT SALARY:

Motion was made by Commissioner Roper and Seconded by Commissioner Mankins to rescind order putting Justice of Peace and County Judge on Straight salary. and setting maximum for Justice of Peace at \$1200.00, County Judge at \$3850.00 plus fees, and County Treasurer at \$3050.00. Motion carried.

 IN THE MATTER OF SETTING SOCIAL SECURITY FUND:

March 29, 1955, Mr. Rudd, By request of the Dept. of Public Welfare, who handles the Social Security program for Texas counties, we are required to set up 4% in the Social Security Fund instead of the original 2%. In order to do this we are requesting that the additional 2% be handled in the same procedure in issuing warrants covering the amount needed from the same funds that they were issued from when the program was set up.
