IN THE MATTER OF REEPING COUNTY AND PRECINCT OFFICERS ON FEE BASIS FOR THE YEAR 1956
The matter of compensation for County and Precinct Officers came up for consideration and motion was made by Commissioner Mankins to keep all officers of the County (excluding Sheriff Constable, County Surveyor, Registrars of Vital Statistics and Motaries Public) on a fee basis for the year 1956.
