 IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING COUNTY TREASURER MONTHLY REPORT:

Motion was made by Commissioner Ponder and seconded by Commissioner Mankins to approve County Treasurer's monthly report. Motion carried.

 IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING OFFICER'S MONTHLY EXPENSE ACCOUNTS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Banks and seconded by Commissioner Roper to approve Officer's monthly expense accounts. Motion carried.

 IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING DEPUTATION OF A. F. VAUGHN:

Motion was made by Commissioner Roper and seconded by Commissioner Banks to approve deputation of A. F. Vaughn as Deputy Sheriff, as of 1 August 1956 at a salary of \$225.00 per month. Motion carried.

 IN THE MATTER OF TRANSFERRING FUNDS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Banks and seconded by Commissioner Mankins to transfer \$400.00 from Gen Co. into Peace Officer's fund. Motion carried.

 IN THE MATTER OF CANCELING WARRANTS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Ponder and seconded by Commissioner Roper to cancel all warrants or checks issued by Titus County prior to January 1, 1956. Motion carried.

 IN THE MATTER OF RAISING COUNTY AGENT'S CLERK:

Motion was made by Commissioner Roper and seconded by Commissioner Banks to raise County Agent's Clerk from \$160.00 to \$175.00 per month, effective 1 Sept. 1956. Motion carried.

 IN THE MATTER OF RAISING SHERIFF'S CLERK:

Motion was made by Commissioner Banks and seconded by Commissioner Ponder to raise Sheriff's Clerk from \$100.00 to \$110.00 per month effective 1 Sept. 1956. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF RAISING COURT REPORTERS SALARY:

WHEREAS the Official Court Reporter of the 76th Judicial District of Texas, J. B. Redfearn of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, is at present drawing a salary of \$5700.00 per year, (or \$475.00 per month) apportioned among the five counties of the District, and

WHEREAS due to the high prices of food commodities and other increases in the cost of living, the present salary is not in keeping with the advance of living costs. And the Court deems that the salary should be increased \$30.00 per month, or an increase of \$360.00 per year, making a salary of \$6060.00 per year, or \$505.00 per month, commencing August 1st, 1956, and to be apportioned prorata among the five counties on a per month basis as follows:

Franklin County -----	63.96
Marion County -----	126.10
Norris County -----	83.36
Titus County -----	148.22
Total	\$505.00
