whereas the official Court Reporter of the 76th Judicial District of Taxas, J. B. Redfearn of Mt. Pleacant, Texas, is at present drawing a salary of \$5700,000 per year, (or \$175.00 per month) apportioned among the five counties of the District, and

WHEREAS due to the high prices of food commodities and other increases in the cost of living, the present salary is not in keeping with the advance of living costs. And the court deems that the salary should be increased \$30.00 per month, or an increase of \$360.00 per year, making a salary of \$6060.00 per year, or \$505.00 per month, commencing August 1st, 1956, and to be apportioned prorate among the five counties on a per month basis as follows:

Marion County -----126,10

Morris County ----- 83.36
