 IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING COUNTY TREASURER'S MONTHLY REPORT:

Motion was made by Commissioner Ponder and seconded by Commissioner Roper to approve County Treasurer's monthly report. Motion carried.

 IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING OFFICER'S MONTHLY REPORTS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Mankins and seconded by Commissioner Banks to approve officer's monthly reports of County Officials. Motion carried.

 IN THE MATTER OF CLOSING AIRPORT ROAD AS PUBLIC ROAD:

Motion was made by Commissioner Banks and seconded by Commissioner Roper to approve the following: Motion carried.

"That the Air Port Road in Titus County, Texas, from the East side of the Mt. Pleasant Municipal Airport to its intersection with the O'Tyson Avenue Road, is hereby closed as a public road as such time as the O'Tyson Avenue Road is made passable to all types of traffic. The Air Port Road now runs directly North of and along the North side of the Municipal Airport and plans are now under way to extend the runway North which would cross this road and in order that said runway might be extended, it is necessary that said road be closed from the East side of the airport property on South to the intersection with O'Tyson Avenue road. However, if it is determined that that portion of the road lying to the West of the airport will serve any purpose, it will be left open, but in any event the road will be closed, discontinued and abandoned as such through the airport property."

Motion was made by Commissioner Banks and seconded by Commissioner Mankins to approve the following letter from Harry Taylor, County Judge to State Department of Public Welfare in regards to the eligibility requirements for those who are needy, motion carried.

Gentlemen:

Listed below you will find the eligibility requirement set up by the Commissioner's Court

of Titus County, Texas for those who are needy to qualify:

STANDARD OF ELIGIBILITY

1. A citizen of the United States
2. A resident of Texas for (1) year and of Titus County, Texas for (6) months
3. Family members under the age of eighteen (18) years shall not be considered employable
4. Income for 1 person must not exceed \$60.00 per month; 2 to 3 persons \$115.00 per month; 4 to 5 persons \$140.00 per month; and from 6 persons on \$165.00 per month.
5. Resource maximum: 1 person--\$300.00, 2 persons--\$450.00.
6. Recipients of Old Age Assistance, Aid to the Blind and Aid to Dependent Children may be eligible to receive commodities provided they meet other qualifications.

I trust that the above stand of eligibility will meet with the approval of your department.
