IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING COUNTY TREASURERS MONTHLY REPORTS

Notion was made by Commissioner Banks and seconded by Commissioner Bynum to approve County Treasurer's monthly report. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING OPPICERS MONTHLY EXPENSE ACCOUNTS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Mankins and seconded by Commissioner Eurnieutt to approve officers monthly expense accounts. Motion carried. IN THE MATTER OF APPOINTING THOMAS W. RENFROE, N. D. TITUS CO. HEALTH OFFICER:

Motion was made by Commissioner Banks and seconded by Commissioner Bynym to appoint Thomas W. Renfroe, M. D. Titus County Health Officer. Motion carried. IN THE MATTER OF TRANSFER:

Motion was made by Commissioner Bynum and seconded by Commissioner Humnieutt to Lateral Road transfer \$2000.00 from General County into Preot #4,/as a temporary loan. Notion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF FIRST NATIONAL BANK AS COUNTY DEPOSITORY FOR ALL CO. FUNDS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Banks and seconded by Commissioner Mankins to accept bid of First National Bank, Mt. Pleasant, Texas as County Depository for all county funds for the years 1959 and 1960. Motion carried.

DEPOSITORY BOND FOR COUNTY SCHOOL BUNDS

STATE OF TEXAS NOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, The First National Bank of Mt. Pleasant, Taxas, as Principal, and W.L. Mean, and Leo Wilson, and P. H. Marshall and Jno. B. Stephena, Jr. and D. A. Brogoitti, as sureties, are hald and firmly bound unto Harry Taylor, County Judge of Titus County, Texas, and his successors in office, in the sum of Seventy-five thousand and no/100 DOLIARS, for the payment of which we hereby bind ourselves and our heire, executors and administrators, jointly and severally by these presents.

THE CONDITIONS of the obligation are such that the First National Bank, of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, (No officer or director of which is a member or the Commissioners' Court) was duly and legally chosen by the Commissioners' Court of Titua County, Texas, as depository of the school funds of said county for a period of two years beginning the 15th day of February, A. D. 1959, and ending sixty days from the time fixed by law for the next selection of a depository.

NOW, THEREFORE, the First National Bank of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, agrees to the following, to wit:

 That it will safely keep and faithfully disburse the school funds according to law, and pay such warrants and/or vouchers that may be legally drawn on the funds by legal authority, and that it will account for and report annually a statement of such to the Commissioners' Court and to the Commissioner of Education as is required by law;

- 2. That it will comply with all the provisions of the laws of the State of Texas relating to school fund depositories, that it will perform all duties therein specified, and will execute any and all instruments and documents necessary to evidence its obligation to this county;
- 3. That it will pay interest daily balances on the school funds, provided such may be authorised under rules, regulations or by-laws promulgated by the Federal Reserve Board.

THEREFORE, if said bank shall perform all duties hereinabove specified this obligation shall be null and void, otherwise it shall remain in full force and effect.

The above provisions are given in addition to any remedy the county may have in any suit brought on this obligation in any court in this State. Any suit arising out of or in any way connected with this obligation shall be tried in the County of Titus, State of Texas, in any court therein having jurisdiction of the subject matter thereof.
