IN THE MATTER OF ABOLISHING VOTING BOX NO. 22:

IN THE MATTER OF COURT ORDER BE SENT TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY AND DISTRICT ROAD INDESTEDNESS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Hunnicutt and seconded by Commissioner Mankins that a court order be sent to the Board of County and District Road Indebtedness requesting the return of \$23,011.21 to Titus County from the surplus lateral road funds. This money will be used by the county to maintain, construct, and repair lateral county roads, and shall be place in the lateral road fund of Titus County. Motion carried.

PETITION FOR ROAD BOND ELECTION

THE STATE OF TEXAS

TO THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF TITUS COUNTY, TEXAS:

We, the undersigned resident property taxpaying voters of said County, who own taxable property in said County and who have duly rendered the same for taxation, respectfully pray your Honorable Body to order an election to dtermine whether or not the bonds of said Titus County shall be issued in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Pollars (\$200,000.00), bearing interest at a rate not to exceed five per cent (5%) per amum, and maturing at such times as may be fixed by the Commissioners' Court, serially or othewise, not to exceed thirty (30) years from the date thereof, for the purpose of the construction, maintenance and operation of macadamised, graveled or paved roads and turnpikes, or in aid to thereof, in said County; and whether or not an ad valorem tax shall be levied upon all the taxable property in Titus County for the purpose of paying the interest on said bonds and to provide a sinking fund for the redemption thereof at maturity.
