THEREUPON, the following ELECTION ORDER was adopted:

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, deems it advisable to submit to the qualified voters of Titus County, who are property taxpayers who own taxable property in said County and who have duly rendered the same for taxation, the propositions hereinafter set forth;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF TITUS COUNT, TEXAS:

That an election be held on the 15th day or September, 1959, at which election the
following propositions shall be submitted.

PROPOSITION NO. 1

SHALL the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, be authorised to issue bonds or said County in the sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00), payable serially over a period of years not to exceed thirty (30) years from their date, bearing interest at a rate not to exceed five per cent (5%) per annum, and to levy a tax sufficient to pay the current interest on said bonds and create a sinking fund sufficient to redeem them at maturity, for the purpose of constructing improvements to the Titus County Courthouse, as authorized by the Constitution and Laws of the State of Texas.

PROPOSITION NO. 2

SHALL the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, be authorised to issue bonds of said County in the sum of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00), payable serially over a period of years not to exceed thirty (30) years from their date, bearing interest at a rate not to exceed five per cent (5%) per annum, and to levy a tax sufficient to pay the current interest on said bonds and create a sinking fund sufficient to redeem them at maturity, for the purpose of constructing improvements to the Titus County Jail, as suthorized by the Constitution and Laws of the State of Texas.
