PETITION FOR ROAD BOND ELECTION

THE STATE OF TEXAS
COUNTY OF TITUS

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TITUS COUNTY, TEXAS:

We, the undersigned resident property taxpaying voters of said county, who own taxable property in said County and who have duly rendered the same for taxation, respectfully pray your Honorable Body to order an election to determine whether or not the bonds of said Titus County shall be issued in the amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00), bearing interest at a rate not to exceed five (5%) per cent per annum, and maturing at such times as may be fixed by the Commissioners Court, serially or otherwise, not to exceed twenty (20) years from their date, for the purpose of the construction, maintenance and operation of macadamized, graveled or paved roads and turnpikes, or in aid thereof, in said county; and whether or not an ad valorem tax shall be levied upon all the taxable property in Titus County for the purpose of paying the interest on said bonds and to provide a sinking fund for the redemption thereof at maturity.
