TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS COURT, TITUS COUNTY, TEXAS.

Gentlemen:

About two weeks ago Mr. J. B. Redfearn the official shorthand reporter for the 76th Judicial District Court suffered a slight stroke and will be unable to perform his duties until around the first day of April. I enclose an order I have prepared designating Mr. Jack G. Scott deputy reporter for the month of March. Article 2323, revised civil statutes of the State of Texas, provides he shall receive the same salary as the official reporter is receiving and during such disability the official reporter shall receive his salary in full. Under the statute Mr. Scott will receive the same salary you are now paying Mr. Redfearn. I understand Mr. Redfearn withholding is done by Titus County and during Mr. Scott's short employment I would suggest he be paid in full without any withholding.

Will you please be so kind as to instruct your clerk and treasurer to make payment to Mr. Scott after the month of March? Should something occur which prevents him from serving I will notify you.
