WHEREAS it is to the interest of Titus County, Texas to acquire property by Eminent Domain Proceedings for use as Right of Way for the improvement of the road system of the said County and the State of Texas; and

MHEREAS it is necessary to appoint certain Special Commissioners for the purpose of assessing damages in Eminent Domain Proceedings and to pay such appointed Special Commissioners a reasonable fee for their service; and

WHEREAS the fact that the present fees paid to such Special Commissioners are grossly inadequate, making it difficult to obtain qualified persons to serve as Special Commissioners, and now that the limits heretofore paid do not comply with the existing laws of the State of Texas as amended by the 56th Section of the Legislature in which Art. 3266(3) Revised Civil Statutes of Texas was amended by House Bill 289 which became effective as law on the

30th day of May. A. D. 1959: THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVES THAT the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, hereby establishes a fee of Five (\$5.00) Dollars for Special Commissioner, per case, per day to be paid to each such Special Commissioner for each day that they are engaged in the performance of their duties, and it is expressly understood and resolved that such Special Commissioners shall be paid Pive (\$5.00) Dollars for each case or proceeding on which they may be required to work during a day regardless of the number of cases or proceedings on which they may be required to work, and such fees will be cumulative, which amount is deemed reasonable, and a just compensation for the services performed by the said Special Commissioners.
