RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING AND INSTRUCTING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO PUBLISH MOTIGE OF INTENTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TITUS COUNTY, TEXAS, TO ISSUE PERMANENT IMPROVEMENT WARRANTS.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court deems it advisable and necessary to construct repairs and improvements to the existing County Courthouse of Titus County, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court deems it advisable and necessary to issue ineterest bearing time warrants against the Permanent Improvement Fund of Titus County forthe purpose of evidencing indebtedness to be incurred in constructing repairs and improvements to said Courthouse and for necessary expenses incidental thereto;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TITUS COUNTY, TEXAS:

That the County Judge be, and he is hereby authorised, ordered and directed to
do all things necessary and/or convenient to have published the notice required by Chapter
163, Acts of the Regular Session of the Porty-second Texas Legislature, as amended; that
said notice shall signify the intention of the Commissioners Court of said County to
issue not exceeding \$100,000.00 of Permanent Improvement Warrants, to mature at such times
as may be fixed by the Commissioners Court, serially or otherwise, with a maximum maturity
not to exceed thirty-five (35) years from their date, to bear interest at a rate not to
exceed five (5\$) per cent per annum, for the purpose of evidencing indebtedness to be
incurred in constructing repairs and improvements to the existing County Courthouse

of Titus County, Texas, and for necessary expenses incidental thereto; such time warrants to be payable out of an ad valorem tax to be levied against all taxable property in said founty.
