IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING OFFICERS MONTHLY EXPENSES:

Motion was made by Commissioner Bynum and seconded by Commissioner Hunnicutt to approve officers monthly expenses. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING COUNTY TREASURERS MONTHLY REPORT:

Motion was made by Commissioner McAnally and seconded by Commissioner Raney to approve County Treasurers monthly report. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF A COURT ORDER BE AUTHORIZED:

Motion was made by Commissioner McAnally and seconded by Commissioner Bynum that a court order be authorized, audit hereby be so ordered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that the Board of County and District Road Indebtedness return \$22,556.21 to Titus County. This money will be used by Titus County to maintain, construct, and repair lateral county roads, and shall be place in the lateral road fund of Titus County. Motion carried. IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING ANNE SUTTERFIELD AS COUNTY HOME DEM AGENT:

Motion was made by Commissioner McAnally and seconded by Commissioner Bynum to approve Anne Sutterfield as County Home Demonstration Agent for Titus County effective 1 October 1962 at cost of \$2110.00 per year to Titus County. Motion carried.

 IN THE MATTER OF RELOCATING UTILITIES FOR HIGHWAY BY-PASS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Hunnicutt and seconded by Commissioner McAnally to relocate utilities for Highway by-pass at an appx. cost of \$3200.00 to Titus County. Motion carried.

 IN THE MATTER OF PAYING PAT SOUTHERLAND:

Motion was made by Commissioner Hunnicutt and seconded by Commissioner Haney to pay Pat Southerland \$48.00 for 6 days work in District Clerks office. Motion carried.

 IN THE MATTER OF HIRING MILDRED KEY FOR TAX OFFICE:

Motion was made by Commissioner Haney and seconded by Commissioner Hunnicutt to hire Mildred Key for tax office work at the rate of \$175.00 per month effective July 16, 1962. Motion carried.

 IN THE MATTER OF EXTRA CLERKS IN THE TAX OFFICE:

Motion was made by Commissioner Hunnicutt and seconded by Commissioner Haney to hire four (4) extra clerks at the request of the tax collector, effective August 16, 1962, at \$1.10 per hour. Two clerks to be terminated at end of Sept. 1962, and the other two on or before 20 November 1962, said clerks to be paid from officers salary fund. Motion carried. The above and foregoing minutes were read and approved for August this the 31st day of August, 1962.
