N. Burt & Company, Richardson, Texas, as an investment for the Titus County Permanent School Fund the following described municipal bonds at the prices listed:

- \$5,000 City of Houston 2 1/2% Tax Bonds, due \$4,000 5/1/78; \$1,000 5/1/79
- \$5,000 City of Lubbock 2 1/2% Tax Bonds, due 1/1/80 and
- 5,000 City of Ft Worth 2.70% Tax Bonds, due 3/1/80 in exchange for
- 11,000 City of Jayton, Texas 2 1/2% Tax Refunding Bonds, due 4/1/73
- 500 Winnfield Ind. School District 3% Bond, due 4/1/63
- 400 Cookville Ind. School District 3 1/2% Bond, due 4/1/63
- 300 Cookville Ind. School District 3 1/2% Bond, due 4/1/63

plus 2,800 cash, correct interest adjustment to be made involving the various bonds.
