IN THE MATTER OF HIRING A AUDITOR:

Motion was made by Commissioner Raney and seconded by Bynum to hire Bill Caçon as Auditor of Titus County, he is not to exceed \$1,000.00. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF HIRING MRS. WELCH TO SELL POLL TAX AND CAR TAGS IN TALCOO:

Motion was made by Commissioner Raney and seconded by Commissioner McAnally to hire Mrs. Welch to sell poll tax receipt in Telcoo, also car Registration. Motion carried.
