TITUS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT.

WHEREAS, Titus County Commissioners Court has previously entered into a Right of Way Contract with the State for a project extending from U. S. 67 West of Mt. Pleasant to West City Limits of Mt. Pleasant, and

WHEREAS, THE City of Mt. Pleasant has adjusted its City Limits over-lapping a portion of the right of way project, and

WHEREAS, The City of Mt. Pleasant has agreed to take over the responsibility of acquiring the necessary right of way in this project previously approved between the State and Titus County, and

WHEREAS, it is to the mutual benefit of the State and the County to execute the Cancellation of the Contractual Agreement for Right of Way Procurement;

NOW THEREFORE the Titus County Commissioners Court approved for execution the right of way contract form and hereby authorizes the County Judge to sign the cancellation of Contractual Agreement form for the County and the County Clerk to attest to same; and have the County Seal affixed thereto, and the County Commissioners Court hereby authorizes the County Judge to execute any additional contract with the State on Right of Way Contracts or Modifications of Contracts that have been previously approved by the Commissioners Court.
