IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING OFFICER'S MONTHLY EXPENSES:

Motion was made by Commissioner Raney and seconded by Commissioner Bynum to approve the Officer's monthly expense accounts. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING THE COUNTY TREASURER'S MONTHLY REPORT:
