IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING COUNTY TREASURERS REPORT:

. Motion was made by Commissioner Driggers and seconded by Commissioner Raney to approve the County Treasurers Report. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING THE OFFICERS MONTHLY EXPENSES:

Motion was made by Commissioner Bynum and seconded by Commissioner Driggers to approve the Officers monthly expense accounts. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF PARKING LOT BEHIND BULLINGTON'S DRUG STORE:

Motion was made by Commissioner Driggers to discontinue the paying of the parking lot rent known as Starks property behind Bullington's Drug Store as of November the 1st 1965. Motion carried.
