Tucker & Co., Inc., TITUS COUNTY ROAD AND BRIDGE WARRANTS, SERIES OF 1963, dated February 15, 1963, Numbers 46 to 75, inclusive, of the denomination of \$1,000.00 each, aggregating \$30,000.00, evidencing the indebtedness due by Titus County to James C. Tucker & Co., as assignee of said claims; that the excess of \$1,548.43, as shown by said list of claims, shall be paid in cash to James C. Tucker & Co. by Titus County, Texas.

The County of Titus having received full value and consideration for the warrants hereinabove described, the County Treasurer is hereby authorized and instructed to register said warrants, and after registration thereof, to deliver same to James C. Tucker & Co., Inc., and the County Judge, County Clerk, and County Treasurer are hereby authorized and instructed to execute such other and further instruments, certificates or statements as shall be necessary, convenient or appropriate to reflect the entire validity of said warrants.
