IN THE MATTER OF DISTRIBUTION OF STATE GASOLINE TAXES FROM STATE BOND BOARD:

Motion was made by Commissioner Parr and seconded by Commissioner Driggers that a court order be authorized and it is hereby so ordered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas that the Board of County and District Road indebtedness return \$22,556.21 to Titus County. This money to be used by Titus County to maintain, construct and repair lateral County Roads and shall be placed in the Lateral Road Fund of Titus County. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF HIRING MINORS UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE.

IN THE MATTER OF CREATING JUSTICE OF PEACE OFFICE, PRECT 1 PLACE NO. 2:

Motion was made by Commissioner Raney and seconded by Commissioner Parr that Justice of Peace Office Prect 1 Place 2 be created. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF APPOINTING A JUSTICE OF PIECE FOR PRECT 1 PLACE 2:

Motion was made by Commissioner Parr and seconded by Commissioner Raney that a Justice of Piece for Prect 1 Place 2 be appointed to begin work on Sept. 1, 1967. This appointment to be good until after General Election in November, 1968. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF SHERIFF SALARY:

Motion was made by Commissioner Raney and seconded by Commissioner Morris that Sheriff Mrs. L. A. Redfurns salary be \$5400.00 per annum. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF CAR EXPENSE FOR SHERIFF AND CHIEF DEPUTY JACK HICKS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Parr and seconded by Commissioner Morris that Mrs.

Radfearn be paid beginning Sept, 1967, \$25.00 per month car expense and that Jack Hicks be paid \$35.00 per month in addition to his regular expense account as long as he is acting in the capacity of Chief Deputy. Motion carried.
