 IN THE MATTER OF COUNTY TREASURERS REPORT:

Motion was made by Commissioner Parr and seconded by Commissioner Morris to approve County Treasurer report. Motion carried.

 IN THE MATTER OF OFFICERS MONTHLY EXPENSE ACCOUNT:

Motion was made by Commissioner Raney and seconded by Commissioner Parr to approve officers monthly expense accounts. Motion carried.
