TO THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF TITUS COUNTY, TEXAS

We, the undersigned resident legally qualified property taxpaying voters of said County, who own taxable property in said County and who have duly rendered the same for taxation, respectfully pray your Honorable Body to order an election to determine whether or not the bods of said Titus County, Texas, shall be issued in the amount of \$950,000, bearing interest at a rats not to exceed five and one-half per cent (5-1/2%) per annum, and maturing at such times ds may be fixed by the Commissioners' Court, serially or otherwise, not to exceed thirty-five (35) years from their date, for the purpose of the construction, maintenance and operation of macadamized, graveled or paved roads and turnpikes, or in aid thereof, in said County, and whether or not an ad valorem tax shall be levied upon all the taxable property in fitus Count; for the purpose of paying the interest on said bonds and providing a sinking fund for the redemption thereof at maturity.
