 IN THE MATTER OF PASSING THE RESOLUTION ACCEPTING PROVISIONS OF STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION:

Motion was made by Commissioner Parr and seconded by Commissioner Raney that we pass the Resolution accepting the Provisions of State Highway Commission Minute Order #61257. This being a resolution for F. M. Road from Highway #271 to Franklin County Line, being a F. M. Road of 2.4 miles. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF THE ABANDONED ROAD BED AT WHITE OAK CREEK:

Motion was made by Commissioner Raney and seconded by Commissioner Parr that the Abandoned road bed at White Oak Creek, North, next to the C. D. Thomas property be given to C. D. Thomas. Motion carried.

 IN THE MATTER OF EASEMENT BE GIVEN TO CITY OF TALCOO:

Motion was made by Commissioner Raney and seconded by Commissioner Parr that an easement be given to City of Talcoo for water line on County Road, commonly known as Crawford Road, beginning at Ark. La. Gas Company to Highway 271. Motion carried.

 IN THE MATTER OF COUNTY AND DISTRICT ROAD INDEBTEDNESS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Parr and seconded by Commissioner Morris that the County give an order to the Board of County and District Road Indebtedness that it return the sum of \$22,556.21 to the County and that this money will be used for construction or improvement of County Lateral roads. Motion carried.

 IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING THE TAX ROLLS FOR 1968:

Motion was made by Commissioner Parr and seconded by Commissioner Morris to approve the Tax Rolls for 1968. Motion carried.
