RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the development of a major fourlane highway from the Red River to the Gulf Coast is needed, and

WHEREAS, let it be resolved that we the County Commissioners of Titus County, State of Texas, will cooperate with the Texas Highway Department on construction of a four-lane road on U. S. 271 in Titus County.
