and the following proceedings were had to-wit:

 IN THE MATTER OF EQUALIZATION BOARD MEETING:

The Equalization Board met with 50 persons concerning their taxes. The board was dismissed at 4:00 PM.

 IN THE MATTER OF SETTING TAX RATE FOR 1969:

Motion was made by Commissioner Roney and seconded by Commissioner Parr to set tax rate for 1969 at .95¢ per \$100.00 valuation. Motion carried.

 IN THE MATTER OF NEW ADDING MACHINE FOR TAX OFFICE:

Motion was made by Commissioner Roney and seconded by Commissioner Morris to purchase a new adding machine for Tax Office and repair the old machine. Motion carried.

 IN THE MATTER OF REDISTRICTING COUNTY PRECINCTS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Parr and seconded by Commissioner Morris to redistrict County Precincts according to the following description to go into effect Sept 1, 1969, this is to confirm with U. S. Supreme Court ruling. Motion carried.

PRECINCT NO. 1: All that certain land situated in the County of Titus, State of Texas, and bounded as follows BEGINNING at the point of intersection of White Oak Bayou with the west line of Titus County, said beginning point being the southwest corner of Precinct No. 3;

TRENCE Easterly with White Oak Bayou to Farm Road No. 1402;
 TRENCE Southerly with said Farm Road to Interstate Hwy. No. 30;
 TRENCE Southwesterly with said Interstate Hwy. to N. Jefferson Avenue in Mt. Pleasant;
 TRENCE Southerly with N. Jefferson Avenue to First Street;
 TRENCE Westerly with First Street and Farm Road No. 899 to Tankersley Creek;
 TRENCE Southerly with Tankersley Creek to Farm Road No. 128;

THENCE Southwesterly with said Farm Road to a point which is 0.5 miles East of the West boundary line of Titus County;
 THENCE North to Farm Road No. 1734;
 THENCE Westerly with said Farm Road to a point where said Farm Road turns due South at a point 1 1/2 miles East of the West County line, and from that point continue due West to the point of intersection with the said West line of Titus County;
 THENCE North along said West line to the place of beginning.

PRECINCT NO. 2: All that certain land situated in the County of Titus, State of Texas, and bounded as follows:
 BEGINNING at the southwest corner of Titus County;
 THENCE North along the West line of Titus County to the southwest corner of Precinct No. 1;
 THENCE East intersecting Farm Road No. 1734 and continuing Easterly along said Farm Road to a point which is 4.8 miles due East of the West line of Titus County;
 THENCE South to Farm Road No. 127;
 THENCE Northeastly along said Farm Road to Tankersley Creek;
 THENCE Northerly along Tankersley Creek to Farm Road No. 899;
 THENCE Easterly along said Farm Road and along First Street to Jefferson Avenue;
 THENCE South along Jefferson Avenue approximately 1.7 miles to the point of intersection of a County Road running Southeastly;
 THENCE Southeastly with said County Road to Farm Road No. 2348 at a point approximately 1.1 miles South of State Hwy. No. 49;
 THENCE Southeastly along said Farm Road to a point which is 3 miles West of the East line of Titus County;
 THENCE South to Big Cypress Creek;
 THENCE Westerly along said Creek to the place of beginning.

PRECINCT NO. 3: All that certain land situated in the County of Titus, State of Texas, and bounded as follows:
 BEGINNING at the northwest corner of Titus County;
 THENCE Easterly along the Sulphur River to the northeast corner of Titus County;
 THENCE South along the East line of Titus County to Interstate Hwy No. 30;
 THENCE Southwesterly along said Interstate Hwy. to Farm Road No. 1001.
 THENCE Southwesterly with said Farm Road to U.S. Hwy. No. 67;
 THENCE Southwesterly with said highway to Harts Creek;
 THENCE Southerly with Harts Creek to State Hwy No. 49;
 THENCE Northwestly with said highway to Choctaw Street;
 THENCE Northwestly with Choctaw street to Quille Avenue;
 THENCE North with Quille Avenue to First Street;
 THENCE West with First Street to Jefferson Avenue;
 THENCE North with Jefferson Avenue to Interstate Hwy. No. 30;
 THENCE Northeastly with said highway to Farm Road No. 1402;
 THENCE Northerly with said Farm Road to White Oak Bayou;
 THENCE Westerly with White Oak Bayou to the point of intersection with the West line of Titus County;
 THENCE North with said County line to the place of beginning.

PRECINCT NO. 4: All that certain land situated in the County of Titus, State of Texas, and bounded as follows:
 BEGINNING at the southeast corner of Titus County;
 THENCE Northwestly along Big Cypress Creek to a point 3 miles West of the East line of Titus County;
 THENCE North to Farm Road No. 2348;
 THENCE Northwestly along said Farm Road to the point of intersection with a County Road at a point approximately 1.1 miles South of State Hwy. No. 49;
 THENCE Northwestly along said County Road to Jefferson Avenue;
 THENCE North along Jefferson Avenue to First Street;
 THENCE East with First Street to Quille Avenue;
 THENCE South with Quille Avenue to Choctaw Street;
 THENCE Southeastly with Choctaw Street to State Hwy. No. 49;
 THENCE Southeastly with said highway to Harts Creek;
 THENCE Northerly with Harts Creek to U.S. Hwy. No. 67;
 THENCE Northeastly with said highway to Farm Road No. 1001;
 THENCE Northeastly with said Farm Road to Interstate Hwy. No. 30;
 THENCE Northeastly with said highway to the East line of Titus County;
 THENCE South with said County line to the place of beginning.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING THE ANNUAL REPORT AND DELINQUENT TAX ROLL:
