Being located in Titus County, Taxas, a part of the Joseph Lesch Survay, Abst. No. 337, and a part of a 5 acre treat described in a deed from E. L. Sincleir et ux to Charles W. Sincleir, deted May 16, 1969, removeded in Vol. 352, page 498 of the Deed Records, sTitus County, Taxas, said road being ; described as being 30 feet in width and extending along a line commencing at the NEC of said 5 acre tract and running generally in a South-Southwest direction to a point approximately 40 years north of the SBL of said 5 acre tract.
