IN THE MATTER OF PAVING RESOLUTION:

Motion was made by Commissioner Raney to pass resolution of Ark Tax Council of Governments, motion seconded by Commissioner Farr. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION OR ORDER

WHEREAS, Article 1011m, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, authorizes counties, cities, towns, villages, authorized districts and other political subdivisions of the State to join and cooperate with each other to

Improve the health, safety and general welfare of citizens; to plan for future development of communities, areas and regions so that transportation systems be more carefully planned; that communities, areas and regions grow with adequate street, utility, health, educational, recreational and other essential facilities, that needs of agriculture, business and industry be recognized; that residential areas provide healthy surroundings for family life; that historical and cultural value be preserved; and that the growth of the communities, areas and regions be commensurate with and promotive of the efficient and economical use of public funds; and

WHEREAS, Acts of the 61st Texas Legislature, 1969 amended Article 1011m, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, authorizing the creation of Interstate Regional Planning Commissions; and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Cooperation Act of the State of Arkansas, being Arkansas Act 430 of 1967, provides that any governmental power or powers, privileges or authority exercised or capable of exercise by a public agency of this State alone may be exercised and enjoyed jointly with any other public agency of this State which has the same powers, privileges or authority under the law, and jointly with any public agency of any other State or the United States, which has the same powers, privilege or authority, but only to the extent that laws of such other States or of the United States permit such joint exercise of enjoyment; and

WHEREAS, said Article 1011m, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, also provides that said governmental units shall by Ordinance, Resolution, Rule, Order or other means agree to membership of a Regional Planning Commission and Arkansas Act 430 of 1967 provides that any two or more public agencies may enter into agreements with one another for joint or cooperative action by Ordinance, Resolution or otherwise pursuant to law of the governing bodies of the participating public agencies; and

WHEREAS, Titus County is of the opinion that the best interests of the public would be served if Titus County would join in with an Interstate Regional Planning Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT Titus County hereby joins in:

Membership of an Interstate Regional Planning Commission established under Article, 1011m, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, and Arkansas Act 430 of 1967, and adopts the attached Articles of Agreement of the Ark-Ex Council of Governments; and

WHEREUPON Commissioner Roney moved the adoption of said Resolution, which said motion was seconded by Commissioner Farr and, upon being put to a vote, carried (Unanimously) with all members present voting "aye" a quorum being present.
