Righmay 1734 as shown by the 'EXHIBIT A' herate attached; provided Industrial Generating Company pays all cost of such relocation, including, but not limited to, engineering, right-of-way, relocation of utilities and construction; 2 (2) Titus County will assist in acquiring the right-of-way by condemnation, if necessary, or any other methods, all of which will be at the expense of Industrial Generating Geopany; and (3) The County Clerk will attest said resolution and place the seal of the county thereon."
