Commissioner Parr offered the following resolution and moved its adoption, and which was accorded by Commissioner Raney, to-wit:

"Whereas, on the 5th day of January, 1971, an agreement was entered into by and between Industrial Generating Company and Titus County covering the construction and maintenance of county roads, railroad structures and approaches near the Monticello Steam Electric Station; and more specifically this agreement provided that Industrial Generating Company had the license and permit to relocate a portion of a North-South county road which is a short distance East of Winfield and intersected IH-30 access road on the South, and which was shown on a map attached to the agreement as "Site 6"; also relocate the intersection of a county road with FM 127 on the H. C. Harvey land shown as "Site 5" on the map; and construct a grade separation structure and suitable relocation of the county road over a railroad shown on the map as "Site 7", reference to said agreement being here made for a full and complete description of the contents thereof; and

WHEREAS, Industrial Generating Company has, at its expense, made or caused to be made and completed the said improvements in accordance with the plans, agreement and specifications; and

WHEREAS, the said improvements have been inspected by the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas; and the court has found same to be completed in all respects in accordance with the plans, agreement and specifications:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas:

(1) Accept the said relocated roads and grade separation structure, as well as all appurtement works, in their entirety; and does hereby, in all things, discharge Industrial Generating Company, its agents, servents, employees or contractors from further obligation to Titus County on said roads;

(2) Titus County agrees that hereafter it will be solely responsible for the future maintenance of the relocated roads and grade separation structure;

(3) Titus County Does hereby abandon as a part of the county road system such portions of the county roads as have been replaced and/or relocated under and by virtue of said agreement as the same are no longer needed as a part of the county road system nor necessary for the traveling public."

Upon a vote, all voted "Aye" and none voted "No"; and the County Judge declared the resolution adopted.
