ACCEPTING RELOCATED AND REBUILT COUNTY ROAD AND ABANDONING A
PORTION OF A COUNTY ROAD

BE IT REMEMBERED that the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas met in regular session on the 11th day of September, 1972 after due notice to all members and posting of notice as required by law. The following were present:

Commissioner Parr offered the following resolution and moved its adoption, and which was seconded by Commissioner Raney, to-wit:

"Whereas, on the 12th day of June, 1972, an agreement was entered into by and between Texas Utilities Services, Inc. and Titus County covering the construction and relocation of a small segment of the county road running from Monticello to Winfield on account of the old road being flooded by waters from a lake now being constructed in connection with the Monticello Steam Electric Station, with Texas Utilities Services, Inc. furnishing the right-of-way and paying the cost of the construction, and the construction to be done by Titus County; and

WHEREAS, the improvements have been made and completed by Titus County, accepted by the county, and are now in use:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas:

- (1) That the County accept the said relocated road and declare that the same is, in all things, completed in accordance with the plans and specifications;
- (2) Titus County agrees that hereafter it will be solely responsible for the maintenance of the relocated road;
- (3) Titus County does hereby abandon as a part of the county road system that portion of the road which has been relocated inasmuch as the abandoned portion is no longer needed as a part of the county road system nor necessary for the traveling public."

Upon a vote, all voted "Aye" and none voted "No"; and the County Judge declared the resolution adopted.
