WHEREAS, the detention facilities of the City of Mt. Pleasant and the County of Titus fail to comply with the standards prescribed by law; and,

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, has considered the matter and deemed to appropriate to cooperate with the City of Mt. Pleasant in obtaining state and federal funds in the construction and operation of a detention facility to be used by both city and county governments. Such facility to be constructed on properties owned by the City of Mt. Pleasant, and further that the County of Titus agrees to share in the cost of such facility.

Be It, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, TEXAS: That the may of the City of Mt. Pleasant request of the Ark-Tax Council of Governments that a feasibility study be conducted to determine the needs for a detention facility to be shared by the aforesaid units of government.
