RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Titus County Commissioners' Court has previously authorized Wayne W. Landrum to enter into negotiation with the Ark-Tex Council of Governments for a grant for the employment of a person qualified under the Federal Emergency Employment Act of 1971 and;

WHEREAS, we have been advised that a grant has been approved to the Ark-Tex Council of Governments by the State of Texas for the aids to employment called for under this act and;

WHEREAS, it is understood that a contract will be entered into between Titus County and the Ark-Tex Council of Governments for a Grant to Titus County for 90% of the expense of such employment;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Wayne W. Landrum and W. H. Camlin be authorized to execute such contract under the terms called for in such act.
