IN THE MATTER OF PAYING ROAD HANDS

Motion by Commissioner Martin and seconded by Commissioner Bynum to pay road hands upon approval of County Auditor. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF ADVERTISING FOR SHERIFF'S CAR

Motion by Judge Landrum and seconded by Commissioner Taylor that County Auditor advertise for bids on one (1) car for sheriff's department. Said bids to be opened on November 11, 1974. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING OFFICERS' EXPENSE ACCOUNTS TO COMMISSIONERS & COUNTY JUDGE'S CONVENTION

Motion by Commissioner Parr and seconded by Commissioner Taylor to pay officers' expense accounts to Commissioners' and County Judges' convention upon approval of County Auditor. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING HIGHWAY 49 CONDEMNATION

Motion by Commissioner Taylor and seconded by Commissioner Parr to approve condemnation on Highway 49 project, on the following named parties upon approval of County Auditor. Motion carried.

Check in the amount of \$4,500.00, payable to the District Clerk, Titus County, Texas, subject to the Order of Jeffie Keith and husband, Folk Keith; and Windred Tabb.

Check in the amount of \$3,500.00, payable to the District Clerk, Titus County, Texas, subject to the Order of Isora Berry, a widow.

Check in the amount of \$2,750.00, payable to the District Clerk, Titus County, Texas, subject to the Order of H. M. Sloan and wife, Myrtle Sloan.

Check in the amount of \$13,500.00, payable to the District Clerk, Titus County, Texas, subject to the Order of Arnold White, and wife R. Letha White; Ercy Gertrude Shuford, and husband, Phillip Frank Shuford, and Wayne Endsley and wife, Juanita Endsley, lienholders.

According to the Commissioners Award, the County has the pending responsibility for the Isora Berry and Jeffie Keith tracts; Modella Brooks and H. M. Sloan are to build their own fences, and Sloan can keep his cattle guard if he will have it moved.
