Keith Survey now or formerly owned by R.H. Smith, and running thence southerly and sectorly to a point which is approximately the southwest corner of a 31-1/2-acre tract now or formerly owned by Sam Milliams and the northwest Corner of a 93-acre tract nor or formerly owned by T.A. Perkins, both in the Joseph Heachem Survey, be, and it is hereby, closed and discontinued as a part of the county road system of Titus County, Texas."
