This Agreement is hereby made and entered into by and between Titus County, Texas, hereinafter called "First Party" acting herein by and through its duly elected and acting Commissioners' Court and Tax Assessor-Collector, and Maurice Love, hereinafter called "Second Party":

W I T N E S S E T H

WHEREAS, Article 7336F, Vernon's Annotated Civil Statutes, as amended, directs and authorizes the collector of taxes of Titus County, Texas, to cause to be compiled a delinquent tax record of all taxes which have become delinquent and which have not been included on the compiled delinquent tax records of said County, and provides for the payment of the cost thereof, such cost in no case to exceed a sum equal to twenty cents (20¢) per item or written line of such record:

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed by and between said "First Party" and "Second Party" as follows:

1.

"Second Party" hereby agrees that he will furnish the necessary labor and perform the services necessary to compile and deliver, complete with recapitulation statement and ready for binding, an original compiled list of such delinquent taxes and two copies (the first copy of which said Second Party will deliver to the State), covering the years 1939 to 1973, both years inclusive, which shall be submitted to the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, for correction and/or approval on or before the 1 day of May, 1975.

2.

"First Party" agrees that upon approval of said compiled list of delinquent taxes prepared by "Second Party" by the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, it will pay to said "Second Party" for his services and labor a sum equal to twenty cents per item or written line of the original copy of such record.

Such payment shall be made by the Tax Collector of Titus County, Texas, proportionately from each the State and County taxes, and other taxes due taxing units which are collected by said Tax Collector, first collected from such record.
