1 355 discussion as to the location of this road so as not to bisect the lands of any of the owners, and after the discussion, there was no action by the Court. However, the Court instructed the attorney and engineer to make further investigation as to the possible locations of a road and consult with the affected land owners, and report to the Court at its next regular meeting on <sup>A</sup>ugust 9. The crossing on Andy's Creek was then discussed, and in this area, the District proposes to run a read around the morth extension of the Lake on this Creek, this road to be County road type on a 50-foot right-of-way, and when so constructed, the present road across this Creek would be abandoned.
