Article 5972 of the Texas Revised Civil Statues requires each newly elected Justice of the Peace to complete a forty hour course in the responsibil of the J.P. office and additionally to complete a twenty hour course each year thereafter. This article encompasses all justices who took office since August 30, 1963 and are not licensed attorneys. nsibiliti

We at the Training Center realize how important it is to you and the people you serve to insure that your county Justices of the Peace are properly trained and equipped to carry out the duties and obligations of the office. As approximately minety to minety-five percent of our citizenry have their one and only contact with a lower court judge, it is imporative that this contact be as judicious as possible.

You may wish to enter this letter in the minutes of your next commissioners court meeting in order that it may become a permanent record. If we at the Training Center can ever be of assistance, please do not hasitate to call.
