

1. That it will safely keep and faithfully disburse the school funds according to law, and pay such warrants and/or vouchers that may be legally drawn on the funds by legal authority, and that it will account for and report annually a statement of such to the Commissioner's Court and to the Commissioner Of Education, as is required by law;
2. That it will comply with all the provisions of the laws of the State of Texas relating to school fund depositories, that it will perform all duties therein specified, and will execute any and all instruments and documents necessary to evidence its obligation to this county;
3. That, at the expiration of the term for which it has been chosen, it will turn over to its successor all the funds, property, and other things of value, coming into its hands as depository, and return the securities pledged to the pledgor. In the event of violation of any or all conditions of this contract, the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, is hereby authorized to sell at public or private sale, with or without notice to the pledgor, the securities of any part thereof, and apply the proceeds of sale to the satisfaction of any or all conditions of this contract.

THE CONDITIONS of this contract are such that if the said depository bank shall perform all obligations hereinabove specified it shall be null and void, otherwise it shall remain in full force and effect. The above provisions are given in addition to any remedy the pledgee may have in any suit brought on this contract in any court in this State. Any suit arising out of or in any way connected with this contract shall be tried in the County of Titus, State of Texas, in any court therein having jurisdiction of the subject matter thereof.

Notice of said meeting and of the matters to be considered having been duly posted in the time, manner, and form required by law. When among other matters there came on to be offered the following resolution:

"WHEREAS on 14 March 1977 the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, adopted an Order stating that it was the intention of the Court to close and abandon as a part of the public road system of Titus County short segments of two county roads, namely;

- (1) Running from the northwest corner of a 103.5 acre tract out of the Evander Leech Survey, formerly owned by Wilke Bennett and running south along Bennett's west boundary line to F.M. 1734; and,
- (2) Running in a northwesterly direction from F.M. 1734 beginning a short distance west of the southeast corner of the said Wilke Bennett 103.5 acre tract to a point near the center of the south boundary line of a tract out of the Evander Leech Survey owned by A.T. Buckner; and substitute in lieu of the segments to be closed a road which will begin at the northwest corner of the Wilke Bennett 103.5 acre tract and run in a southeasterly direction following generally the southeast boundary line of a tract of land formerly owned by E.A. Mattingly to the north boundary line of a tract formerly owned by A.T. Buckner and which will be the northwest end of the segment to be closed described in paragraph 2 above, and continue in a southeasterly direction across the A.T. Buckner land to a point at or near the southeast corner of a 3 1/4 acre tract in the Joseph Matthews Survey formerly owned by John R. Latot, and which point is on the north right-of-way line of F.M. 1734; and

WHEREAS Texas Utilities Generating Company has constructed the segment of road to be used in lieu of the portions closed and which has been inspected and the court finds that the same has been constructed in accordance with the requirements of the Commissioners Court; and,

WHEREAS an easement has been executed in favor of Titus County on the substituted roads and Texas Utilities Generating Company has agreed to maintain said road for a period of 6 months from and after this date. NOW THEREFORE the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, agrees that:

1. The two segments of road as mentioned above as (1) and (2) be and they are hereby closed and abandoned as a part of the public road system of Titus County;
2. In lieu of the abandoned segments, the Court accepts as a part of the county road system of Titus County the road above described as constructed by Texas Utilities Generating Company with the provision that said company will maintain same for a period of 6 months from this date;
3. The Court accepts the easement from L.D. Cross, Trustee, on the substituted segment of county road."
