The vater area three hundred feet upstream on the Monticello Reservoir Dam-gate facilities is zoned e
Denger Area and will be identified as such by placement of "can" type buoys dieplaying the universal
markings of a dismond with inner cross and the words "Denger Keep Out" on a perimeter of three hundred feet upstream from the fece of the gate fecilities.

Also, due to the dlippery surfaces and atrong water current and undertow, the immediate shoreline adjacent to the gate facilities is goned a danger area and will be so marked by signs reading "Restricted Are Keep Out". HIGHWAY BRIDGE STRUCTURES-"No Waje Areas" The vater area two hundred feet on either side of PM 127 Bridge Structure is zoned "No Weke Area" and will be so identified by placement of "can" type buoys displaying "No Weke" encircled, two hundred feet out buoys displaying "No Wake" encircled, two hundred feet out from the bridge and two hundred feet spert. 7. OTHER AREAS Other grass where the Yexas Parks & Wildlife Depertment identified a hazard to life or property may be dasignated as no boating of no wake areas with installation of appropriate marking. These areas may include future marins sites, bagge areas, shoels, shoreline sbutments, and other water horards.
