

4. WATER INTAKE STRUCTURES- "Texas Utilities Generating Company, inlet and outlet channels"

The water area three hundred feet in front of the Monticello Steam Electric Station intake structure and three hundred feet below the end of the outlet structure are zoned Danger Areas and will be so identified by placement of "can" type buoys displaying the universal markings of a diamond with the inner cross and the words "Danger Keep Out" on a perimeter of three hundred feet on the water side of both structures.

The danger area will be further identified by placement of a "capsule" buoy line outlining the perimeter of the swift current area.

5. MONTICELLO RESERVOIR DAM INLET AND OUTLET STRUCTURE- "Danger Areas"

The water area three hundred feet upstream of the Monticello Reservoir Dam-gate facilities is zoned a Danger Area and will be identified as such by placement of "can" type buoys displaying the universal markings of a diamond with inner cross and the words "Danger Keep Out" on a perimeter of three hundred feet upstream from the face of the gate facilities.

Also, due to the slippery surfaces and strong water current and undertow, the immediate shoreline adjacent to the gate facilities is zoned a danger area and will be so marked by signs reading "Restricted Area-Keep Out".

6. HIGHWAY BRIDGE STRUCTURES- "No Wake Areas"

The water area two hundred feet on either side of FM 127 Bridge Structure is zoned "No Wake Area" and will be so identified by placement of "can" type buoys displaying "No Wake" encircled, two hundred feet out from the bridge and two hundred feet apart.

7. OTHER AREAS

Other areas where the Texas Parks & Wildlife Department identified a hazard to life or property may be designated as no boating or no wake areas with installation of appropriate marking. These areas may include future marina sites, barge areas, shoals, shoreline abutments, and other water hazards.

8. VIOLATION OF ZONING REGULATIONS

Any person who violates or fails to comply with any part of this zoning plan shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined not exceeding \$200.00

9. This zoning plan will (a) be submitted to Texas Parks & Wildlife Department at 4200 Smith School Road, Austin, Texas, 78744, for approval; (b) will thereafter be published in full in a newspaper published in Titus County, Texas; and (c) the buoys mentioned herein will be placed, and upon completion of (a), (b), and (c) above, the zoning plan becomes effective. As buoys are placed in any area, that area will come under the plan.

Motion made by Commissioner Parr to adopt the zoning plan, seconded by Commissioner Reynolds and upon a vote all voted "AYE" and none voted "NO", and the County Judge declared the zoning plan adopted.
