In TITUS COUNTY a FARM TO MARKET BOAD is hereby designated extending from the end of Farm to Market Road 3417, approximately 2.4 miles West of U.S. Highway 271, Northwest and North to Farm to Market Road 127, a distance of approximately 2.1 miles, subject to the condition that Titus County will furnish all required right of way clear of obstructions and free of cost to the State and acquisition procedures will be in accordance with applicable Federal and State laws governing the acquisition policies for acquiring real property.

At such time as the County shall eccept the provision of this Order and agree to the furnishing of the required right of way, the Engineer-Director is directed to proceed with the engineering development, Relocation Assistance at an estimated cost of \$1,000.00 and construction of the project in the most feasible and economical manner at an estimated cost of \$300,000, financing the cost in the next appropriate program. and to assume the road for State maintenance upon completion of the construction.

This Order is subject to ecceptance by the County and if not accepted within 90 days of the date hereof, the action herein contained shall be sutomatically cancelled.
