MINUTE ORDER

In TITUS COUNTY a FARM TO MARKET ROAD is hereby designated extending from the end of Farm to Market Road 3417, approximately 2.4 miles West of U.S. Highway 271, Northwest and North to Farm to Market Road 127, a distance of approximately 2.1 miles, subject to the condition that Titus County will furnish all required right of way clear of obstructions and free of cost to the State and acquisition procedures will be in accordance with applicable Federal and State laws governing the acquisition policies for acquiring real property.

At such time as the County shall accept the provision of this Order and agree to the furnishing of the required right of way, the Engineer-Director is directed to proceed with the engineering development, Relocation Assistance at an estimated cost of \$1,000.00 and construction of the project in the most feasible and economical manner at an estimated cost of \$300,000, financing the cost in the next appropriate program, and to assume the road for State maintenance upon completion of the construction.

This Order is subject to acceptance by the County and if not accepted within 90 days of the date hereof, the action herein contained shall be automatically cancelled.

ORDER PERTAINING TO PUBLIC SCHOOL OF INSTRUCTION

On this the 2 day of March, 1978, it having been called to the attention of the County Judge, William Wayne Landrum, that the V.T.C.A, Alcoholic and Beverage Code, Section 251.36, captioned "Public School of Instruction", provides that

"The County Judge shall cause to be held a public school of instruction for those who actually conduct the election at the polling places not less than three (3) days before the local option election."

IT IS FOUND that the County Judge of Titus County, Texas, the Honorable William Wayne Landrum, hereby finds that it is his duty to cause to be held a public school of instruction for the above mentioned election.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Honorable William Wayne Landrum finds that Bird Old, III, is a competent and qualified person to hold such public school of instruction.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Bird Old, III, shall hold said public school of instruction on the 7th day of March, 1978.

IT IS FURTHER FOUND that the above mentioned statute provided that the County Clerk shall post in his office a notice of the time and place of the school at least forty-eight (48) hours before it is held and that the County Clerk shall notify each presiding judge of the time and place where the school is to be held.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the County Clerk of Titus County, Texas, Allen LaPrade, shall post notice of the time and place of the school at least forty-eight (48) hours before it is held, said notice to be posted at his office. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Allen LaPrade, the County Clerk of Titus County, Texas, shall notify each presiding judge of the time and place where the school is to be held.

IT IS FURTHER FOUND that said statute requires each presiding judge to notify each appointed clerk and watcher of the election in his precinct of the time and place of the school.

IT IS THUS ORDERED that each presiding judge shall notify each clerk and watcher of the election of the time and place of school.

IT IS FURTHER FOUND that said statute pertaining to the public school of instruction provided that said school shall be open to any interested person.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the said school shall be open to any and all interested persons.
