RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the existing conditions constitute a serious hazard and inconvenience to the public and the citizens of Titus County; and
WHEREAS, the County request the State of Texas to construct this urgently needed project; and
WHEREAS, the State of Texas has made it known to the County that the State will assist the County in the construction of the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY TITUS COUNTY, TEXAS:

Section 1. That since the public convenience and safety require it, said project shall be constructed.

Section 2. That the County Judge be and is hereby authorized to execute for and on behalf of the County a Municipal Construction and Maintenance Agreement with the State of Texas in accordance with and for the purpose of carrying out the terms and provisions of this resolution, in the form attached hereto and marked "Exhibit B". The County Judge is further authorized to approve and sign the detailed plans for construction of the project or any section thereof when and as such plans are completed and prior to award of construction contract by the State. The County Clerk is hereby directed to attest the agreement and plans, and to affix the proper seal of the County thereto;

Section 3. That the State of Texas be and is hereby authorized to enter upon and construct the project at the location and in the manner shown on the plans to be approved by the County Judge and attached hereto, marked "Exhibit A", and made a part hereof in all respects.

RESOLUTION OF THE TITUS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT WITH REVIEW AND COMMENT ON AN APPLICATION BY TITUS COUNTY TEXAS CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION FOR A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$ 34,490.00 TO BE MATCHED WITH \$ 3,449.00 LOCAL CASH, FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A JUVENILE PROBATION DEPARTMENT AND STATUS OFFENDER PROGRAM; WHEREAS, the county of Titus agree to match the grant with 10% cash for the first year and 20% cash match on second year funding on the per capita basis described in the application, and, WHEREAS, it is desirable and in the public interest that the application be reviewed by the Ark-Tax council of Governments for its consistency with the overall development of the Region,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TITUS COUNTY:

Section 1 - That the application by Titus County, Texas to the Texas Criminal Justice Division for grant in the amount of \$ 34,490.00 to be matched with \$ 3,449.00 cash, to establish a juvenile probation department and status offender program has been reviewed by the Commissioners Court and can reasonably be expected to become a part of the overall Regional Plan.

Section 2- That the above mentioned improvements are desirable and urgently needed for the public safety and welfare.
