

Nothing herein contained shall be construed to place upon the State any manner of liability for injury to or death of persons or for damage to or loss of property arising out of or in any manner connected with the maintenance or use of: Project, and the City or County will save the State harmless from any damages arising from said maintenance and/or use of said Project.

It is further understood and agreed between the parties hereto that the construction of the Project by the State is for the sole purpose of providing the traveling public a more adequate travel facility and shall never be the basis of any claim for State exemption or participation in the payment of the obligation if the City or County incurred in the improvement, past or present, of any street project.

**GENERAL**

In the event the terms of this Agreement are in conflict with provisions of any other existing Agreements and/or Contracts between the City or County and the State, this Agreement shall take precedence over the other Agreements and/or Contracts.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have hereto affixed their signatures, the City of Mt. Pleasant on the 5th day of July, 1978, the County of Titus on the 23rd day of June, 1978, and the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation on the 25th day of July, 1978.
